## European Congress of Endocrinology 2022

Dear Professor Vitti

Thank you again for the Italian Society of Endocrinology's proposal to host the ECE in 2022 in Milan.

Following positive discussions by the ESE Congress Committee and at the recent ESE Executive Committee meeting, we are pleased to inform you that the ESE Executive Committee was unanimous in their support of the **Milan 2022** bid. I would also like to thank you and the local team for your support in our additional requirements to secure the very best deal for the congress venue and also the tremendous support SIE has offered, as outlined in your letter of 10 September 2018.


Thank you for the suggested dates of **21 - 24 May 2022**. We would like to reserve the required space at the venue Mico (Milano Congressi) on 1st option please. Please also note that we will require build up and breakdown dates either side of the open days. We are pleased to say that after a successful event in Barcelona at ECE 2018, we are expecting a growth to the congress and would like to review meeting room sizes before contracting the specific venue spaces. The ECE Team will get in contact with the venue directly to discuss options.

The ESE Team will be in touch in due course to organise the next steps, which will include discussions with the venue, arrangement of additional site visits, and to start the preparations for the social programme.


